



Information in this product covers 21 1:250 000 and one 1:100 000 map sheets. Detailed data are provided for three of these map sheets, and regional data are provided for the other 25 map sheets.

The 1:250 000 Regolith Geochemistry Series commenced in 1994, with the aim of mapping and sampling map sheets of particular interest for regolith geochemistry or deemed to have high exploration potential.

The data provided for each 1:250 000 sheet is a combination of Explanatory Notes (including a regolith materials map, maps showing outlines of company surface-geochemistry projects, and sample locations), and the various element-distribution maps or plates at 1:250 000 scale. The content of each 1:250 000 map sheet dataset varies.

Also included is regolith geochemistry for the Nicholls 1:100 000 map sheet. The data for this sheet includes partial and total digest results.

Geochemistry Online

Geochemistry Online (GeoChem Extract) provides geochemistry search and extract functions for 1:250 000 map sheets or for the entire State. It is a multi-element geochemistry database of rocks and regolith, which provides base-level information for mineral exploration.
