


Broome – Dampier Peninsula – Derby: Basic raw materials, 2013

This data package provides information on the potential availability of basic raw materials (BRM) within a 100 km radius of Broome and Derby, including Dampier Peninsula. All main sources of BRM, including sand, gravel, limestone, limesand, and sandstone, have been identified. Other major sites that are potential sources of these materials, taking into account high-level constraints such as Class A Nature Reserves and coastal vulnerability, have also been identified. Quantitative information for BRM, including particle size distribution of granular samples and chemical analyses of carbonate materials, are provided for the Broome area.
