



### Western Australia hosts world-class gold deposits

- Western Australia's gold production for 2022–23 was 6.9 Moz, worth over \$18 billion
- First gold was poured at Bellevue, Kat Gap, Jeffreys Find and Pilot (Altan Rio) projects. Mining commenced at Selkirk (Brightstar Resources)
- Focus Minerals resumed gold production at the Coolgardie Operations with commissioning of the Three Mile Hill plant
- Several major projects are now at feasibility or scoping stages, including Hemi Gold (De Grey), Youanmi Gold (Rox Resources), Laverton (Focus Minerals), Katanning Gold (Ausgold), and Ulysses Gold (Genesis Minerals). Havieron is under development
- Significant mineral resource upgrades have been announced for the Hemi Gold, Havieron, Paterson (Rio Tinto), Sunrise Dam, Kanowna (Northern Star), Karlawinda, Katanning Gold and Kundana/Mungari projects
- Significant gold intercepts continue to be announced from several projects in the State, including Youanmi Gold (Rox Resources), Central Norseman (Pantoro), Side Well (Boulder Resources), Lady Julie (Magnetic Resources), Mandilla and Feysville (Astral Resources), Paulsens (Black Cat), Sandstone (Alto Metals), Dalgaranga (Spartan Resources), Garden Gully (Ora Gold), Cue-Moyagee (Musgrave Minerals) and Newman Gold (Peregrine Gold)
