



WAROX lithology notes and site notes

WAROX (Western Australia Rocks) is a database of the Geological Survey of Western Australia field observation sites. The database holds a rich variety of content in a complex relational structure. This includes field notes, rock types, lithostratigraphic relationships, regolith observations, measured structural data, sample details, petrography, and field and thin section photographs.

This dataset is a flat file extract of site field notes and lithology descriptions recorded in the database in a form suitable for display in a GIS application or for textual analysis. A separate complementary extract of aggregated notes from this and other WAROX content is also available.

Survey location metadata coordinates are in GDA94 decimal degrees.
