

Western Australia remains the world's largest producer of iron ore

Record sales of Western Australian iron ore were reached in 2020-21 at \$154 billion.

There are currently 28 iron ore projects operating in the Pilbara region, seven projects operating in the Mid West and Goldfields regions and one operation in the Kimberley region.

New mines

- First ore has been produced from Rio Tinto's Gudai-Darri operation and Phase 2 of its Western Turner Syncline project
- · Atlas Iron has hauled first ore from its Sanjiv Ridge operation to the Utah Point Berth in Port Hedland
- · BHP's South Flank has delivered first ore as production ramps up to its anticipated 80 Mtpa capacity, which will add significantly to the Mining Area Chub
- First ore was achieved in 2021 less than five months after breaking ground at Mineral Resource Ltd's Wonmunna project with production rates set to reach 5 Mtpa with further plans for expansion
- Other mines that started production in 2021 were Wiluna West (GWR Group Ltd and CuFe Ltd), Iron Ridge project (Fenix Resource), and Parker Range - Mt Caudan (Mineral Resources Ltd)
